


Data and Data Analytics

Three elements that will lead to transform ational change from GALLANT...

Doughnut Economics

- frames economic development through social, ecological, local and global lenses
- co-production from the start, moving toward place-based values
- forum for international shared learning

Community Collaboration

- deep partnership, building confidence, trust, knowledge & agency local people shape climate action
- shifting culture so unis & local/nationalgovt)
 - value local expertise
 - share power more openly
 - embed co-creation in decision-making

Inter/transdisciplinarity

- Increased capacity for interdisciplinary research across the UofG demonstrate what works
- A new cohort of ECRs using whole systems approaches as the norm
