



Overview






- Reflects a shift in research funding valuing collaboration, societal relevance, and alignment with national priorities like climate action and equity.

- Responds to **urgent**, **lived challenges** making climate action locally grounded and socially just.




Impact

- Hosted over 10 major events, convening stakeholders from communities, government, academia, and industry
- Launched six seed funds aligned with key themes: Decarbonising Heat, Financial Pathways, and Sustainable Households
- Facilitated two annual training workshops through the Emerging Research Leaders Programme, supporting early career researchers across disciplines
- Contributed to two Scottish Government consultations , ensuring local insights and lived experiences informed climate policy
- Leveraged Alliance funding to unlock £40 of collaborative research investment for every £1, amplifying impact during a time of financial constraint.
